

2022 Y.ES Artist Grant Application

Application deadline: October 25, 2022

Y.ES Artist Grants are dedicated to supporting exhibition, project and travel opportunities.

The grant is open to international artists from, working in, or
dealing with themes pertinent to El Salvador.

This year, YES grants total \$5,000 and will be awarded for **exhibitions**, **projects** and **travel opportunities** occurring between January 1-December 31, 2023.

Support may be requested for \$2,500, and grants are awarded by an independent jury of art experts.

(Please note: grants do not support studio production without an exhibition or project outcome).

Grant Eligibility:

- Grants may be used towards exhibition/project production, transport, flights, accommodation, and insurance (including medical for travel).
- An individual or an art collective may apply.
- Only one application per artist/ collective/ project will be considered.
- Grant awardees are selected by an independent jury of art experts, however a follow up interview with Y.ES staff for additional details may be requested.
- If you have already received a Y.ES Grant we ask that you wait 1 year to apply.
- Y.ES councilmembers and staff are not eligible to apply for a Y.ES Grant.

Apply by uploading an application pdf to yescontemporary.org/apply including:

- 1. Your resume/CV
- 2. An explanation of the exhibition, project or opportunity you are asking Y.ES to support in no more than 250 words. Please include sketches and/or images on additional pages in the pdf.
- 3. If invited by an institution/organization for a travel opportunity or project collaboration please include the institution/organization letter of invitation.
- 4. A budget outlining what the grant will be spent on. Please specify the amount you are applying for between \$1,000-\$5,000.

Report Requirements:

- During the project you will be asked to do a YES social media takeover sharing documentation of your exhibition/project/residency.
- Grant reports are due within 30 days of project completion, and should include:
 - a. A 100-word written report explaining the impact and results of the grant project or opportunity with images from the project or opportunity.
 - b. Copies of the expense receipts covered by the Y.ES grant in a single pdf.
- We ask that grantees provide Y.ES with a copy of all findings, and/or publications developed as part of the supported project for the Y.ES Contemporary archive.
